HALLECK STREET REOPENS

Friday, March 16

Halleck Street – a major connection between the Main Post and Crissy Field – will reopen to pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists on Friday, March 16. This opening marks another major milestone for the Presidio Parkway project that has transformed the northern waterfront for

San Francisco, turning an aging, outdated roadway into a graceful parkway and gateway to San Francisco and the Presidio National Park. The street closed in 2012 to make room for the Temporary Bypass and has been rebuilt over the eastern portals of the Main Post Tunnels.

As part of the Halleck Streetscape restoration, Building 201, a former Army forage storehouse, was relocated and restored. This structure was moved to make room for the construction of the Main Post Tunnels, and has now been relocated back along Halleck Street.
